As soon to be saint, Blessed Carlo Acutis said, “The Eucharist is my highway to heaven!” We are in the presence of Christ and receive him in the Eucharist.

It is ESSENTIAL!

Sunday, June 21, 2024, wraps us the National Eucharistic Congress in Indianapolis and so begins our last journey of the Revival – the National Year of Mission. From now through Pentecost of 2025, all Catholics are encouraged to evangelize and be a light of Christ in the world.

Christ said at the Last Supper, “This is my Body. This is my Blood!” Our National Eucharistic Revival in this country began on June 19, 2022 – the Feast of Corpus Christi – a day the Church highlights the Real Presence of Jesus in the Eucharist, — Body, Blood, Soul, and Divinity.



The Eucharist is not merely a symbol, Bishop Mark Brennan said. “It is a reality of Jesus coming to us under the appearance of bread and wine – Jesus changes that into His Glorified Body and Blood.”

Catholics from every corner of WV joined Bishop Mark in Indianapolis for this historic moment for our country and our Church. They joined more than 80,000 Catholics from the US for this life-changing moment, experiencing an outpouring of grace, joy, hope, peace, unity, and meaning of Eucharistic faith.

The Real Presence

Our diocesan representatives were able to attend a daily rosary, adoration, reconciliation, liturgy (celebrated in various rites and languages), inspirational breakout sessions, and revival sessions emphasizing Christ working in our lives. Catholic artists, authors, and vendors from all over the country joined missionaries, religious orders, educational institutes and others in the market/expo hall at the congress.

Not only did our delegation get to listen to dozens of national and international dynamic Catholic speakers, but many were able to meet them. Some of those more recognizable names include Bishop Robert Barron, of the Diocese of Winona-Rochester & Word on Fire Catholic Ministries; Sr. Miriam James Heidland, SOLT, author, and inspirational Catholic speaker featured on EWTN, SEEK Conferences, Steubenville Conferences, Abiding Together podcast, and more; Father Mike Schmitz, of Ascension podcasts’ Bible in a Year and Catechism in a Year and is the Director of Youth and Young Adult Ministry for the Diocese of Duluth and chaplain for the Newman Center at the University of Minnesota – Duluth, (BulldogCatholic.org); Fr. Josh Johnson of Ascension Presents/Media, the Ask Father Josh podcast, author of Broken & Blessed; Scott Hahn, professor at Franciscan University, founder and president of the St. Paul Center; and Dr. Edward Sri, Catholic speaker and best-selling author of A Biblical Walk Through the Mass, The Art of Living, Walking with Mary, and Into His Likeness: Be Transformed as a Disciple.

Enriching and uplifting music by Matt Maher echoed all over the campus of the Revival, which encompassed both Lucas Oil Stadium and the Indiana Convention Center.

The Year of Mission

The Eucharistic Congress in Indianapolis ends on Sunday, July 21 but that is not the end of the Eucharistic Revival. Now we embark on the The Year of Mission.

The Four Pillars of Mission

Pillar 1: Eucharistic Encounter

In order to lead people to a relationship with Jesus in the Eucharist, we have to maintain an active relationship with him ourselves. This pillar focuses on deepening that personal relationship through prayer, adoration, and the sacraments. Regular, profound encounters with Jesus strengthen us to be a more authentic and powerful witness to his love.

Pillar 2: Eucharistic Identity

To truly live out our mission as Catholics, we must first embrace our identity as beloved children of the Father, shaped by our relationship with Christ in the Eucharist. This pillar emphasizes the importance of internalizing and living out the teachings and love of Jesus, allowing our Eucharistic encounters to define who we are. Through these encounters, our hearts and minds are transformed, guiding us to reflect Christ's love in every aspect of our lives.

Pillar 3: Eucharistic Life

This pillar encourages us to integrate our love for Christ into every aspect of our lives, transforming daily actions into continuous acts of worship and service. As we love Christ more, our lives become configured to his, reflecting his sacrificial love. When we live a Eucharistic life, we join in Christ's self-offering, allowing his love to flow through us to others.

Pillar 4: Eucharistic Mission

This pillar is a call to evangelize—boldly spreading the Good News of Christ's Eucharistic love and mercy in word and deed. As our love for Christ deepens, our lives will become increasingly configured to his mission, compelling us to serve others with his heart. We will be drawn to compassionate service, living our call to be his hands and feet to our neighbors and bring his presence to the margins.

Virtus Update



In May of 2024, Bishop Mark Brennan announced a yearly continuing Safe Environment education requirement for all employees and volunteers in the Diocese of Wheeling-Charleston. Over the course of the remainder of 2024, we will be executing this directive from the Bishop. In order to effectively implement continuing Safe Environment education, all volunteers and employees in accordance with Diocesan policy must be current with Version 4.0 of Protecting God's Children for Adults. VIRTUS has been the Diocese's training provider since the inception of the Office of Safe Environment more than 20 years ago in accordance with the United States Conference of Catholic Bishops (USCCB) Charter for the Protection of Children and Young People. Over the ensuing years, VIRTUS has periodically updated its Protecting God's Children module. The most current version of the Protecting God's Children module is Version 4.0. Once everyone has completed Version 4.0, we will move toward yearly modules and monthly bulletins for all employees and volunteers in accordance with policy and as directed by the Bishop. We expect the remainder of 2024 to involve getting all employees and volunteers, as identified via Diocesan policy, up to speed with Version 4.0.

What exactly is the Bishop requiring as far as continuing Safe Environment education and for whom?

Effective May of 2024, the Bishop announced that he is requiring the following to achieve compliance with Safe Environment in the Diocese of Wheeling-Charleston for all employees and volunteers:

- Completion of VIRTUS awareness training on a yearly basis
- Completion of monthly VIRTUS bulletins to raise awareness
- Completion of a background check every three years
- Acknowledgement of policy and related documents (policy form, code of conduct, and state of West Virginia reporting requirement)

Please login to your online Virtus Account to check your status. At present, we have over eighty people between the church and the school are not compliant. Please call the parish office if you have questions or require assistance.
